

Fox Islands Wind to be featured at AWEA WINDPOWER 2010 conference

A presentation on Fox Islands Wind has been selected for the WINDPOWER 2010 conference agenda on May 26, 2010. Hosted by the American Wind Energy Association (AWEA), this is the wind-power industry's largest annual event, drawing more than 20,000 attendees from around the world. WINDPOWER 2010 is taking place in Dallas, Texas from May 23 – 26, 2010.
